- British Sign Language: The Committee were updated on the progress that has been made to support NHS 24 meet its requirements as set out in the BSL National Plan 2017 to 2023
- Mental Health Hub: Staff are embracing the new opportunity and initial staff feedback has been good. Examples of staff/public feedback provided - all very positive
- Pharmacy Student Experiential Learning in NHS 24: NHS 24 Head of Pharmacy and the Regional Pharmacy Advisors from Service Delivery were asked to develop and deliver a 5-day programme for 10 Strathclyde University students and 6 Robert Gordon University students. Initial feedback from the students and the Universities has been extremely positive
- Supporting Primary Care Sustainability (Primary Care Reform): Ensure that the CGC processes are in place across the service as we deliver new content
- Service & Quality Improvement: Ensure all clinical content and clinical governance measures in place around new projects before implementation

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- Realistic Medicine: The Committee are pleased to see the close alignment with NHS 24 strategy
- Service Model Implementation: Very positive paper pleased to see the training that has been put in place
- Patient Experience Survey: Very positive feedback including compliments
