1. Purpose of the report

This report provides the NHS 24 Board with an update on key issues arising from the Clinical Governance Committee held on 14 January 2019.

2. Recommendation

The NHS 24 Board is asked to receive and note the key points outlined.

- Clinical Call Review & Overall Clinical Effectiveness: It was agreed that the two deep dive presentations for the March CGC meeting will be:
 - Call Consultation Reviews
 - Better Working Better Care
- Discussion on risks around potential generic clinical strategic risk regarding patient harm. It was agreed this should be included, although it may be categorised as a low risk on the risk register due to the extensive mitigation
- Clinical Risk Appetite: The Committee agreed it be minuted that the Clinical Risk Appetite remain at low
- Outliers: Work is ongoing to level and review the outliers with the CSMs and the valuable learning being gained from feedback received. A report on how the change has improved learning will come to a future CGC
- Discussion on how the new medical devices directive which will include software as medical devices and how this will impact on NHS 24. This legislation will be effective from 2020

- NHS Inform uncoupling from NHS.uk. Discussion on taking ownership of the content and any increased risk for NHS 24.
