### 1. Purpose of the report

1.1. This report provides the NHS 24 Board with an update on key issues arising from the Clinical Governance Committee meeting held on 8 August 2022.

#### 2. Recommendation

2.1. The NHS 24 Board is asked to receive and note the key points outlined.

### 3. Quarterly Healthcare Quality Report

3.1. The Committee reviewed the Quarterly Healthcare Quality Report for Q1 (April-June 2022). The Committee welcomed the improvements which had been made to the report and suggested further improvements to the presentation of data including last 5 quarters and graph format.

# 4. Public Partnership Forum and Youth Forum – Annual Update

- 4.1. The Committee received an update on the work of the Public Partnership Forum and Youth Forum during 2021/22. The Committee were encouraged by the report and reflected on the activity being maintained by the forums during the pandemic.
- 4.2. The Board Chair hoped to encourage members of the forums to observe Board meetings in future.

# 5. Public Protection - Learning and Development Strategy and Annual Report 2021/22

5.1. The Committee received two reports from the Public Protection Service in relation to the Learning and Development Strategy which had been updated

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in line with national guidance and the annual report detailing activity within the service during 2021/22.

# 6. Patient and Service User Feedback and Duty of Candour

- 6.1. The Committee reviewed the Annual Report 2021/22 for Patient and Service User Feedback noting that a very small proportion of calls result in complaints.
- 6.2. The Committee endorsed the Duty of Candour Annual Report for 2021/22 and remittance to the Board for approval.

# 7. Whistleblowing

- 7.1. The Committee received an update in relation to Whistleblowing following publication of the Annual Report for 2021/22 which had been virtually approved by the Board.
- 7.2. An action plan has been developed which included a refresh of the current policy, communications plan, recruitment of confidential contacts and support for the Whistleblowing Champion.
- 7.3. Work is currently underway in preparation for Speak Up week which will take place the 3 7 October 2022.

## 8. Improvement Updates

- 8.1. The Clinical Governance Committee reviewed the workplan for 2022/23 and following discussion agreed to hold a deep dive at the November meeting on Public Health and Realistic Medicine & Care.
- 8.2. The Committee felt the topic of Urgent and Unscheduled Care would be more appropriate at a future Board Workshop.
