3. National Quarterly Healthcare Quality Report

- 3.1. The Committee reviewed the Quarterly Healthcare Quality Report for Q3 (October December 2023), presented by Mrs Laura Neil, Lead AHP / Interim Head of Clinical Governance and Quality Improvement.
- 3.2. The report was presented using the revised format in PowerPoint slides rather than a word document, and the data was presented using SPC (Statistical Process Control) charts where available.
- 3.3. The Committee welcomed the revised format of the report and provided feedback on further improvements which could be made. These will be reviewed and consider for the next meeting.
